The college was named after the late Theophilus Albert Marryshow who was born in Grenada on 7th November 1877. He founded The West Indian newspaper. So outstanding have been his journalistic activities through the years that he was acclaimed an honorary member by the British Caribbean Press Association. In June 1921, Marryshow undertook single-handedly a mission to the British Government to press for Caribbean advancement. His newspaper motto was, "*The West Indies must be West Indian.*"

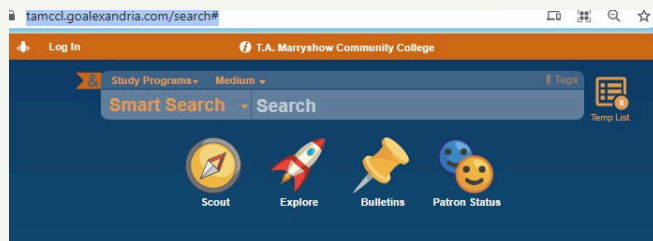
