Biography

Professor Emerita the Most Honourable Violet Eudine Barriteau



Violet Eudine Barriteau is a Grenadian born, Caribbean feminist, scholar and activist with considerable experience in research, executive educational administration and coordination of regional projects. She retired from the University of the West Indies in 2021, as Pro Vice-Chancellor and Principal of the Cave Hill Campus, a position she has held for six years, after serving as Principal and Pro Vice Chancellor of the Open Campus for nine months and Deputy Principal of The UWI, Cave Hill Campus for six years.

As a Professor Emerita of Gender and Public Policy, her research interests encompass transformational educational leadership, feminist theorizing, feminist investigations of Caribbean political economy, and the intersections of gender analysis and public policy. Professor Barriteau served as the Lead Coordinator for the inaugural Gender and Development Forum of the quadrennial UNCTAD XV Ministerial conferences, which was hosted virtually by the Government of Barbados, October 3-7 2021. In February 2021, in her capacity as Chair of the Vice Chancellor's Task Force on Governance, she successfully submitted to The UWI, "A Report on a Governance Model for the IGDS" in which all thirteen recommendations for improved governance of the Institute for Gender and Development Studies were adopted. At the United Nations in June 2024, Professor Barriteau was elected to serve for a four-year term on the United Nations Committee for the Elimination of all Forms of Discrimination Against Women, CEDAW, one of the three United Nations Human Rights Bodies.

In 2020, she served as a Member of the Government of Barbados' Jobs and Investment Council and Chair of the Services and the Creative Economy Committee, one of six sub-committees of the Jobs and Investment Council which was convened to prepare a guide for the survival and transformation of Barbados in a post-Covid environment. The Council accepted the Chair's Report of the Services and Creative Economy Committee, which has since been adopted by the Government of Barbados as a guide for post-covid training. In 2015 Professor Barriteau chaired the CARICOM Prime Ministerial 5-member panel appointed to review the Governance of West Indian Cricket and submitted the Chair's Report with radical recommendations for the transformation of the governance of West Indies cricket to CARICOM in November 2015.

Professor Barriteau migrated from Grenada as a child, attended St Matthias Girls' School, Ellerslie Secondary and gained a BSc honours degree from The University of the West Indies, Cave Hill Campus in 1980. Professor Barriteau holds an MPA in Public Sector Financial Management from New York University, 1984, and a PhD in Political Science from Howard University, 1994. She has published thirty-nine book chapters and peer-reviewed journal articles,

including her first book, *The Political Economy of Gender in the Twentieth Century Caribbean* (Palgrave, 2001).

Her first job was as a Teacher at St. George Secondary, 1972-1978, a post she describes as her best work experience from the tremendous satisfaction she gained teaching young boys and girls.

She has been awarded several academic scholarships and awards from universities and organisations. She was a LASPAU/Fellowship scholar at New York University 1982 – 1984, and the first Caribbean woman awarded the Margaret McNamara Memorial Fund Scholarship in 1991. She was an American Association of University Women scholar, 1992, and was awarded a Howard University Doctoral Fellowship, 1992. In 1997 she was the Inaugural Fellow of the Dame Nita Barrow Distinguished Women in Development Visitor Programme at the University of Toronto. She was an inaugural International Research Fellow at the Centre for Excellence in Gender Research, GEXCEL, Orebro, Sweden, April 2008, and was invited to return in November 2010 and March 2013. In 2018, on its 70th Anniversary, The UWI recognized Professor Barriteau for Outstanding Academic Achievement and Leadership, as one of 70 outstanding Cave Hill alumni.

Professor Barriteau has received a number of national, regional and international awards and recognitions. She was President of the International Association for Feminist Economics (IAFFE) 2009/2010. In July 2011 she was bestowed the Tenth CARICOM Triennial Award for Women at the Thirty-Second Regular Meeting of CARICOM Heads of Government, St. Kitts. In Barbados' 47th Anniversary Independence celebrations, 2013, she was awarded the Gold Crown of Merit, the country's third highest honour in recognition of her invaluable contribution to gender and development. In February 2016 she was bestowed The Order of Grenada Gold Award for Excellence for 2015, at Grenada's 42nd Independence Anniversary celebrations. In the 2019 Independence celebrations, the Government of Barbados conferred on Professor Barriteau, **The Order of Freedom of Barbados**, the country's highest national honour. With this award, she is referred to as, Professor, the Most Honourable.

Professor Barriteau has spearheaded a number of initiatives at the UWI. In 2016, she recommended creating a Faculty of Sport, which The UWI established in July 2017, the first new Faculty to be introduced in 47 years. Professor Barriteau successfully gained recognition for the Cave Hill Campus in meeting comparability of standards for the Faculty of Medical Sciences, Cave Hill from the National Committee on Foreign Medical Education and Accreditation (NCFMEA), October 2016. In 2018, The UWI approved her proposal for the establishment of a Centre for Biosecurity Studies which was fully operational on August 01, 2020. In 2017 Professor Barriteau launched The Smart Campus Initiative, designed to reconceptualise the delivery of higher education goods and services in Barbados and the Caribbean by the harnessing ICT technology to support national and regional development. On August 01, 2020 The UWI established the Faculty of Culture, Creative and Performing Arts. This was the culmination of a proposal developed by Professor Barriteau and approved by The UWI Senate in October 2019.

She is the proud mother of Cabral Fanon Barriteau Foster, and grandmother of Aleah and Amari Barriteau Foster.

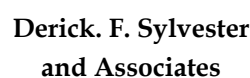
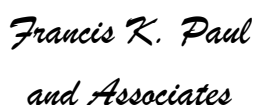
